



Following the previous decision to curtail the 2019/2020 domestic football season in Wales using a points per game method, the FAW Board of Directors met remotely today (16 June) to consider the recommendation of the FAW National Leagues Board and other possible options with regard to promotion and relegation throughout the National Leagues.

Following careful consideration of all options that were available to them, the FAW Board of Directors decided that promotion and relegation should be implemented in line with the existing Pyramid Regulations, based on the final standings in each League/division having applied the unweighted points per game method and subject to Club Licensing/Ground Criteria requirements for the National Leagues. The decision was consistent with the recommendation from the FAW National Leagues Board.

The Community Game Board had previously agreed to adopt a consistent approach in relation to the leagues at Recreational Level.

As a result of this decision, the FAW can confirm the following in relation to its National Leagues:

JD Cymru Premier (Tier 1)

Promoted: Flint Town United; Haverfordwest County

Relegated: Airbus UK Broughton (to JD Cymru North); Carmarthen Town (to JD Cymru South)

JD Cymru North (Tier 2)

Promoted: Llanidloes Town; Holywell Town & Holyhead Hotspur

Relegated: Llanfair United, Corwen & Porthmadog (all to Tier 3 North)

JD Cymru South (Tier 2)

Promoted: Trefelin BGC; Risca United & Port Talbot Town

Relegated: STM Sports (failed to obtain FAW Tier 2 Certification); Cwmamman United & Caerau Ely (all to Tier 3 South)

The National Leagues Board will consider the reorganisation of Tier 3 clubs on July 10th following the Tier 3 Ground Criteria certification process.

Yn dilyn y penderfyniad i gwtogi tymor domestig 2019/2020 yng Nghymru bu cyfarfod heddiw (16eg o Fehefin) gyda Bwrdd Cyfarwyddwyr Cymdeithas Bêl-Droed Cymru (Bwrdd CBDC) i ystyried argymhelliad Bwrdd y Gynghrair Genedlaethol ac opsiynau arall ynglyn a dyrchafu a disgyn ym mhyramid pêl-droed Cymru ar gyfer y tymor 2019/2020.

Wrth ystyried yr opsiynau a oedd ar gael, mae Bwrdd CBDC wedi cadarnhau'r penderfyniad bydd dyrchafu a disgyn yn digwydd ym mhyramid pêl-droed Cymru ar gyfer tymor 2019/2020, fel diffiniwyd yn Reoliadau Pyramid CBDC.

Mae'r penderfyniad yn dibynnu ar safleoedd cynghrair ar ôl cwtogi'r tymor trwy ddefnyddio dull pwyntiau fesul gêm ac/neu Drwydded CBDC / canlyniad Tystysgrif, yn gyson ac argymhelliad Bwrdd y Gynghrair Genedlaethol.

Fe benderfynwyd trwy Fwrdd y Gêm Gymunedol y bydd Pêl-droed Hamdden yn dilyn ôl troed Haenau 1-4 ar sut i ddod â thymor 2019/20 i ben.
